The *Architect-US* **Career Training Program** is overseen by the *U.S. Government Exchange J-1 Visitor Program* under Department of State regulations. To qualify for *Architect-US*'s Program, candidates must meet all of the following requirements at the time of registration:

- · Age: between 18 and 35 years old
- · Enrolled in a PostGrad School or holding a Degree in Architecture or Engineering.
- Be able to communicate in English (interviews with potential employers will be conducted in English)

- · experience not required
- · up to 12 months.

J-1 TRAINEE

- · graduates >1 year
- · young professionals
- · 1 year experience min.
- · up to 18 months.





Booth SPAIN arts & culture competition



The Spain-USA Foundation, in the framework of the SPAIN arts & culture program, organized in 2017 the design contest **Booth SPAIN arts & culture**

The objetive of the design contest was to create a **new exhibition space, modular, removable and mobile,** whose function will be the **promotion** and diffusion of **different artistic disciplines through temporary exhibitions** in Washington D.C.

Based on a proposal of a prestigious jury, the Spain-USA Foundation, will award a prize of \$3,500. In addition to that, there is a budget of \$15,000 for the development of the idea, the direction of the project, and its execution.

The contest was open to Architects with Spanish Nationality and legally entitled (licensed in Spain) to practice the profession, and also multidisciplinary teams.
